Volunteer Descriptions

- Picture Day** – Help manage children while waiting in line. Also help kids with hair and clothes.
- Jog-A-Thon** – Many volunteers needed to help organize the event, help the day of and count money.
- Vision and Hearing Screening** – Bring students to and from classes.
- Pumpkin Carving** – Need help with set-up, clean up and serving refreshments.
- PTA meeting childcare** – Find and organize childcare for PTA general meetings.
- Carnival** – Many volunteers needed to work booths, help with setup, help with cleanup, serve food, and sell tickets.
- Math Mentors** - Volunteers are needed to work one on one with students, practicing math facts using a computer program or math sheets.
- Citizen Planning Committee Rep** – Works with principal and parents on issues involving the school and district. Attend a monthly district meeting throughout school year.
- Neighbors helping Neighbors** – Help coordinate food and gift donations and purchases for needy families.
- Coins for Kids** – Volunteers needed to help count money.
- Box tops/Soup Labels** – Collect tops and labels and send them in to companies to get money and supplies for school.
- Moms and Muffins/Dads and Donuts** – Coordinate a morning social for parents and children and then help in classroom.
- Room Parent** – Assist the teacher and PTA for your class. Help includes organizing activities and informing parents in class of upcoming activities.
- Teacher Appreciation** – Help organize activities for teacher appreciation week.
- Library** – Assist the Librarian with students, shelving books, and checking in and out books.
- Reflections Art Program** – Organize this art program sponsored by the State and national PTA.
- Family Fun Nights** – Help organize a dance, a rollerskating night or a movie night for Seaview families.
- School Directory** – Put together directory of Seaview families.
- 6th Grade Liaison** – Organize and plan events and graduation party for 6th graders.
- Sharkwatch/newsletter** – Submit a short update of PTA activities each month to the Sharkwatch.
- Fund Raising/T-shirt sales** – Help Seaview PTA raise money through t-shirt sales or other events.
- Parking Lot Patrol** – Volunteers needed to supervise busy corners before and after school.
